A story of constant change:

For nearly 200 years Christ Church has been a place of worship for the growing population of Downend and beyond. It has played a central role in community life - the place where local people have come to be married, buried and baptised. Schools have valued it and succeeding generations have cared for it and regularly redeveloped it as times have changed.



1831: Christ Church built

1875: Original pews replaced

1913: Chancel extended to include a sanctuary & rose window

1931: New vestries for choir and clergy added

1956: Parish Hall built

1985: Pews removed at west end to create reception area

2003: Choir stalls removed and chancel enlarged, outside access

2011: Spiritual Garden created

2013: Parish Hall refurbished and Youth Hub built

2017: The story continues

These changes were made because our predecessors were able to recognise the need to adapt the building as new mission opportunities arose. They had the courage to trust God and step out in faith, to give sacrificially and see the work completed.

Our Mission Partners in Moldova



Over the past 5 years our partnership with Pastor Misa and the church in Moldova has resulted in them being able to build the very first church in the village of Ursoaia, thanks to the tithing of monies given so far to our building project. We would like to maintain our support for him and his

What happens next?

The work will cost in the order of £1 million. This includes a substantial amount of long standing repairs to the fabric of the building such as repointing stonework, renewing the drainage, lighting, heating and sound systems, and rewiring and redecorating the whole church. We are blessed to already have half of that amount thanks to generous giving, legacies and the sale of properties. The remainder of the total cost needs to be either given, pledged or secured in grant funding by September so that the work can begin this autumn.

Enriched hospitality

-the kitchen will be twice the current size and there will be a welcome desk by the door. The screen into the nave will slide and can be folded back to allow both spaces to work together. The side balconies will be level and carpeted so that they can be used in all kinds of ways during the weeks as well as Sundays. For example, young children could play safely, or small groups could meet informally.

An environment to lift the spirit


-the Garden Room will have full length windows to let in the light and connect with the Spiritual Garden; the bespoke storage areas will mean that the church will be free from clutter.

Access for all throughout the ground floor

-a new side entrance will be formed and levels lowered so that there are no steps to negotiate and free flowing wheelchair access inside and out.

- new spaces to meet and build relationships, for community groups to gather and for existing ministries to grow such as CAP (Christians Against Poverty), Open Church, Messy Church and Jigsaw.

An adaptable space

-for worship and the creative arts - high quality chairs will replace the pews, new lighting, sound and vision will be installed, drawing on the latest innovative technology.

-for local artists and schools - the walls will be redecorated and made suitable for art installations of all kinds.

-to reflect the uniqueness of this Georgian building and combine it with imaginative contemporary design.

Christian Spirituality

Prayer at the heart of the church

-as a prayer chapel is formed which is simple and sound-proof, offering a place to know God in stillness.

Enriched worship

-as we will have many more options for laying out the main worship area to create space for café church, informal types of services, concerts, drama productions, conferences, 24/7 prayer stations and collective worship for schools.

Respect for the significance of God's creation

-as underfloor heating is laid, draughts excluded, insulation installed and energy loss reduced to a minimum.
