
Christ Church Prayer Life

Opportunities for prayer with others, to which all are welcome:

Mondays at 9.15 – 9.45am Morning Prayer - a simple form of prayer and reflection on a Bible passage following the Church of England's liturgical year. Each week 4 members of our church family are remembered in prayer, responding to specific needs they have highlighted. (Held in the Trinity Chapel).

Wednesdays 7am – 7.30am #ThyKingdomCome prayer – Open prayer for the issues facing our society and the needs of our world. (Held in the Youth Hub)

Once a month - Prayer for Persecuted Christians, Tuesday 19 March & Tuesday 16 April at 9.30am at 39 Cleeve Hill. An hour of prayer with stories of specific situations highlighted by *Open Doors*.

Mahabba Prayer - monthly at 2pm on a Thursday. Please contact the Office if you would like to come to this meeting to pray for Muslims in our locality.

Before Worship and other events- There is prayer before the 10.30 service from 10.10 – 10.25am in the Trinity Chapel to seek to listen to the Spirit. Gatherings for prayer happen before Messy Church, Jigsaw and before and after each youth evening too. Anyone is welcome to be part of these times.
