Opportunities for prayer with others, to which all are welcome:

Mondays at 9.15 – 9.45am Morning Prayer - a simple form of prayer and reflection on a Bible passage following the Church of England's liturgical year. Each week 4 members of our church family are remembered in prayer, responding to specific needs they have highlighted. (Held in the Trinity Chapel).

Wednesdays 7am – 7.30am ThyKingdomCome prayer – Open prayer for the issues facing our society and the needs of our world. (Held in the Youth Hub)

Once a month - **Prayer for Persecuted Christians**, . An hour of prayer with stories of specific situations highlighted by *Open Doors*.
