

Questions for Oct 20th 2019

What does it look like to be a community of grace?

1. How do we see Jesus showing grace in action in the gospels? Eg Luke 17:11-19
Are there clues here to what the marks of a grace-filled community might be.
2. What is the difference between kindness, mercy and grace?
3. What experiences of these have you had at Christ Church?
4. In what ways does Christ church live as a community of grace to its neighbours not just a community of kindness and/or mercy?
5. Jesus is described as being full of grace *and* truth (John 1; 14). If we are to be a community that is full of grace, do we also need to be full of truth if we are to be authentically living the life of Jesus? What might that look like in practice? (Ephesians 4; 15 describes growing in discipleship/maturity in terms of 'speaking the truth in love').
6. How can we practically encourage one another to remember the amazing grace we've given on a day to day basis?
