


Four key **values** shape our life together – thankfulness, openness, graciousness and prayerfulness.

NEXT STEP

Learning to follow Jesus is a marathon, not a sprint! If you are thinking about taking the next step towards him, it doesn't matter if you have barely begun, or have been following him for years, there is always a new step to take on the journey.

We want to encourage, inspire and equip each other so we can make a difference for God where we are each day.

Take a step:

- Join a small group, a life group where you can explore faith with others who are growing together
- Pray alone or with others in workshops, 24/7 prayer events, Quiet Days
- Learn how to read the Bible – the Bible course, life groups
- Find out how to live well in different stages of life: we run a bereavement group, a toddler group, a divorce recovery group, a carers group, women in work group.
